Arrive Kolkata and transfer to your hotel for over night stay



DAY 2 KOLKATTA-GUWAHATI-MANAS NATIONAL PARK

Departure transfer to the domestic airport to connect flight to Guwahati. Arrive Guwahati and drive to Manas National Park (176 kms / 04-05 hours).

Arrive Manas National Park and check in Forest Bungalow for three nights.



Manas National Park is situated on the foothills of the Himalayas and a part of it extends to Bhutan. It was declared a sanctuary on October 01, 1928 and was designated a World Heritage site in December 1985. The sanctuary is home to a great variety of wildlife, including tiger, Golden Langur, Wild Buffalo, Hispid Hare, Pigmy Hog, Capped Langur, Indian one-horned Rhinoceros, Elephant, Gaur, Hog Deer, etc.

Manas known for its Project Tigers, Rhinos & Elephants, and is Assam's one of the two Tiger projects. The scenic beauty and rare wealth of wild life combine with this unique world heritage site to offer one of the most enthralling experiences.

After refreshments proceed for boating on the river to view wildlife along with guide.

DAY 6 GUWAHATI – KAZIRANGA NATIONAL PARK

DAYS 7 & 8 KAZIRANGA NATIONAL PARK

Enjoy early morning Elephant Safari inside the national park.



Kaziranga National Park is renowned as one of the finest and most picturesque wildlife refuges in southern Asia. It protects the world's largest Indian rhinoceros population, as well as many other threatened species. It is situated in Nowgaon and Golaghat districts on the southern bank of the Brahmaputra River at the foot of the Mikir Hills, some 8km from Bokakhat. National Highway No. 37 forms the southern boundary. It was notified as a national park on 11 February 1974. Originally established as a reserved forest in

1908, a game sanctuary in 1916 and a wildlife sanctuary in 1950. Inscribed on the World Heritage List in 1985. It covers an area of 42,996ha, of which some 5,000ha has been lost due to erosion of the northern boundary by the Brahmaputra River. According to official records, the actual land area is 37,822ha. An addition of some 45,450ha is proposed and includes the Brahmaputra River to the north and part of the Mikir Hills to the south. The altitude ranges between 40m and 80m. To the south of the park, the Mikir Hills rise to about 1,220m. Later proceed for a jeep safari inside the park.
